New Exhibit - Egg Contest

1. All eggs must be produced by the exhibitor's own flock (no purchased eggs, store or other producer)
2. All eggs should be clean and fresh, but not washed; and exhibited in a container of the exhibitor's choice – eggs must be visible for public viewing and easily accessible for judging
3. Judging will be on uniformity (color, speckles, size, etc) of eggs, egg shape, shell texture & thickness. Eggs shall be free of defects and abnormalities
4. Eggs may be opened for further judging. Cracked or opened eggs will be disposed of after judging, all other eggs will be displayed throughout the week and available for pick up during entry release. Any eggs not picked up will be disposed of. Exhibitors are responsible for picking up egg containers during entry release.
5. Painting of eggs and egg stamps are not allowed.
6. Please list breed (or breeds in flock if you're unsure which breeds laid your eggs) on entry form.
7. Exhibition is open to any resident in the Laramie Trade Area.
