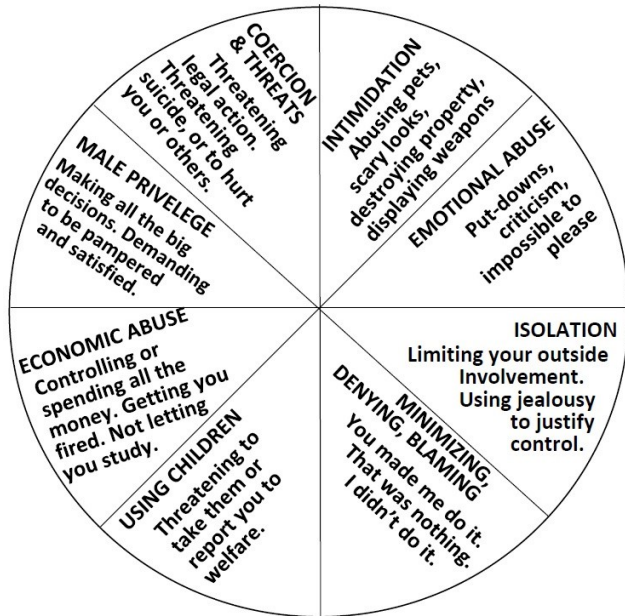


## Power & Control Wheel

### LETHALITY CHECKLIST

*Here are some indicators that abuse may end in murder.*

- Stalking has begun.
- There has been any incident of strangulation.
- Suicide or homicide threats or attempts.
- Weapons are present.
- Threats have been made against children, animals, or the abuse victim.
- Severity or frequency of violence have increased.
- Mental illness or substance abuse are present.
- The victim has left or begun a new relationship.
- The abuser has nothing to lose.
