400 classes are not state fair classes and will not be used to qualify showmen for any classes at the state fair.

## Junior Poultry Show Division 1609

1. Poultry exhibitors must turn in a Poultry ID by June 1 of the current year.
2. Poultry exhibitors may use a current and valid NPIP Certificate in lieu of a health certificate.
3. Parasite checks will be required of all birds at check in.
4. Bedding used in transport cages must be removed from the barn and cages may not be stored inside the barns.
5. All youth market show birds must be banded or tagged by the weigh date in June.
6. All meat pen birds must be hatched on or after January 1 of the current year.
7. Market birds must be weighted clean and dry
8. Minimum and Maximum weights will be as follows:
  - a. Turkeys; Min: 20lbs, Max 37lbs
  - b. Geese; Min: 8lbs, Max 22lbs
  - c. Ducks; Min: 5lbs, Max 16lbs
  - d. Chickens; Min: 5lbs, Max 10lbs
9. All meat pen poultry must be able to support their weight and walk without assistance. If any any point during fair they are not able to, they will not be eligible to exhibit for the show or sale and must be removed from the grounds.
10. No caponized birds will be allowed in the show.
11. Any and all birds currently regulated by the WG&F, or a federal agency, must present documents to show they are in compliance with the regulations set forth by those agencies that govern their species or variety.
12. One meat pen of poultry of two to three is equivalent to one large animal unit.
13. Market entry limits: Each exhibitor may enter a total of 6 pens of market pens with a max of three pens per species.
14. Breeding Bird entry limits: Each exhibitor may enter a total of two (two) birds per class division. There are no limits to the number of breeding birds entered. However, due to space restrictions, exhibitors may be limited to the number of birds kept on grounds during the fair. The superintendent will notify exhibitors if some birds may need to be removed following the show.
15. Breeding birds must be fertile (non mule type) breeds, capable of naturally producing. Market birds entered in a market class may not compete in a breeding class in the same fair.
16. You must check out with the superintendent at the close of the fair, your cages must be completely cleaned out from shavings and all decorations removed.
17. Pens that include one or more underweight animals will be shown in a combined poultry class and will not be eligible for the Junior Livestock Sale.
18. Premier Poultry Breeder
  - This class is not a separate judged class, rather it is calculated based on points. No separate entry is required. To be eligible for premier breeder, two males and two females of the same species must be shown in the breeding class; market poultry are not eligible for premier breeder.

- Points will be awarded based on the placing within the class and how many birds are entered in that class. Additional points will be awarded for Champion and Reserve Champion Large Fowl, Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam, Champion and Reserve Champion Duck, Champion and Reserve Champion Goose, Champion and Reserve Champion Turkey, etc, as well as Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show. Points will be calculated by the Superintendent.
- Point Schedule:
  - 1st Place: 6 points x # of birds in class
  - 2nd Place: 4 points x # of birds in class
  - 3rd Place: 3 points x # of birds in class
  - 4th Place: 2 points x # of birds in class
  - 5th Place: 1 point x # of birds in class
- Placing points will be multiplied by the number of birds in the class. Champion titles will be awarded an additional 5 points Reserve Champion titles will receive an additional 3 points. Best of Show will receive an additional 10 points and Reserve Best in Show will receive an additional 8 points.
- The birds selected by the superintendent will be the two highest point earning males and the two highest point earning females shown by each exhibitor.
- Males and females can be any age with no preference given to older or younger birds.
- If a bird places below 5th in a class, the bird can be used as a placeholder to meet eligibility requirements for the premier breeder title. However, the bird will not be awarded any points calculated toward the total point calculation.
